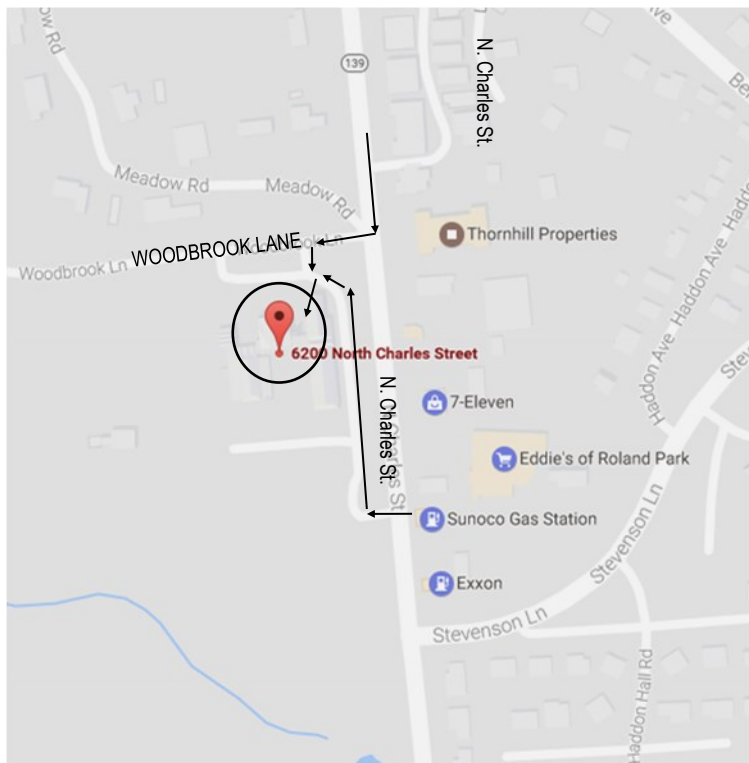

**From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695):
Take Exit 25 South (North Charles
Street) to the Church. The Church is
approximately 3 miles south of the
Beltway at the corner of Woodbrook
Lane and North Charles (between
traffic lights at Bellona Ave. and
Stevenson Lane).**



There are two entrances to the church property—turn in at Woodbrook Lane OR at the church driveway further south. Park at the north end of the building (closer to Woodbrook Lane) and walk a short distance between the side sections of the church complex to the entrance. Signs will be posted.
