



# GENERAL ASSEMBLY Scorecard 2019

## SB 1030

### Blueprint for Maryland's Future, 3rd Reader

MSEA's top legislative priority for 2019, this legislation starts the multi-year implementation of the work of the Commission on Innovation and Excellence in Education (Kirwan Commission). It outlines \$1.1 billion in new state aid for public schools, including funds to increase teacher and certificated staff salaries, expand community schools, increase spending for special education, create new tutoring supports, and invest in new innovative programs. Third reader vote: House (114-20); Senate (45-0).

## HB 166/SB 280

### Minimum Wage—Fight for \$15, Veto Override

Raising the minimum wage will directly achieve an important goal of our efforts by increasing wages for several thousand education support professionals in every corner of the state who make more than the current \$10.10 per hour minimum wage but less than \$15.00. The phase-in will occur by January 2025 and will create an annual increase that will also provide upward pressure to increase other hourly wages for ESPs, legislatively and through bargaining, to reach a living wage standard for all support professionals. The governor vetoed this legislation and the General Assembly voted to override his veto. Override vote: House (96-43); Senate (32-15).

## SB 529/HB 87

### Membership, Teacher & Parent on State Board of Education, 3rd Reader

A direct path to empowering the teaching profession is by adding a dedicated seat to the State Board of Education specifically for a teacher. This legislation adds two new seats to the 12-member State Board: one seat for an active teacher and a second for a parent of a current public school student. The teacher member will be selected based on an election administered by the State Department of Education of all certificated teachers in the state. The parent will be selected by the governor from a list provided by the Maryland PTA. This score reflects a combination of the votes. Some legislators changed their votes even though the bills were identical. Third reader vote for SB 529: House (97-41); Senate (39-5). Third reader vote for HB 87: House (98-37); Senate (45-0).

## SB 537

### DREAM Act Expansion, 3rd Reader

This legislation provides a sensible expansion of efforts to provide new access to higher education opportunities for students commonly referred to as Dreamers. It allows undocumented immigrant students to attend public four-year universities without having to attend community college first. Governor Hogan vetoed this bill after the General Assembly adjourned. Third reader vote: House (92-38); Senate (32-15).

## HB 295

### Prohibit Discrimination at Nonpublic Schools, House 3rd Reader

If Maryland is going to send public taxpayer dollars to unaccountable private schools, the very least it can do is make sure those schools do not discriminate against students and staff on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability. This legislation would prohibit such discrimination. While it passed the House, it was never voted on in the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee. The full House vote is scored here. Third reader vote: 93-47

## HB 100

### Phase Out BOOST Voucher Program, House Appropriations Amendment

Governor Hogan proposed the continuation of the BOOST voucher program at \$10 million for FY20. While MSEA wanted to eliminate the program, we did support the Appropriations Committee's actions to cut the program in half and begin to phase it out so it would only be available to existing voucher recipients. This vote is only scored for the members of the House Appropriations Committee: 16-9

## HB 100

### Phase Out BOOST Voucher Program, Senate Budget and Taxation Amendment

The House voted to phase out BOOST, and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee proposed eliminating the House action and restoring the full amount of the voucher program as proposed by Governor Hogan. While the conference committee ultimately settled on less money for the BOOST program, the Senate committee position to allow the program to add new students also was part of the final compromise. This vote is only scored for the members of the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee: 7-6
