This award will highlight "rookie" teachers who are successfully developing as professional educators and who are going the extra mile in providing quality education for students and a positive image of education and educators.


A person who has demonstrated creativity, implemented a successful project, or done admirable work may be nominated.

Care should be taken to select someone who shows great promise to be an exemplary educator for years to come.



- 8. Three (3) TABCO members seconding the nomination (*other than the nominator*) must submit letters of support postmarked on or before February 14, 2020. These letters should provide specifics supporting the nomination.
- Only original forms with original signatures will be accepted. No copies, faxes, emails or otherwise.
- 10. Nomination packets (including the second nomination form, signatures and letters of support) must be received at the TABCO office or postmarked by February 14, 2020. *Late packets will not be accepted.*
