

## TABCO SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of need and academic/community achievement regardless of choice of profession **only** to children whose parents:
  - a. are active TABCO members.
  - b. have been TABCO members for at least three total years.
  - c. were active members of TABCO at the time of retirement.
  - d. were active members of TABCO at the time of death.
- Each scholarship is given for a one-year period and may be considered for renewal upon reapplication.
- Recipients must be entering or enrolled in an undergraduate program in a college or university accredited by its regional association.
- Applications may be secured from TABCO Association Representatives, school counselors, the TABCO office by contacting Ana Negrete-Garcia at <a href="mailto:anegrete-garcia@mseanea.org">anegrete-garcia@mseanea.org</a> or website <a href="www.tabco.org">www.tabco.org</a>.

## The student must:

- 1. Complete all sections of the application form. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. Submit a one-page essay stating your goals and aspirations in the field of study you have chosen to pursue or are pursuing in college.
- 3. Submit a record of academic and extracurricular accomplishments, awards, etc.
- 4. Submit evidence of involvement in community activities.
- 5. Submit <u>one letter of character reference</u> written by an individual other than teachers or school administrators.
- 6. Submit two letters of academic reference written by individuals who have taught and/or counseled the student in school.
- 7. The student must request and ensure delivery of an OFFICIAL transcript from his/her high school or college record to the TABCO Scholarship Committee.

NOTE: Please include only requested items.

## **General Information:**

All required information must be received in the TABCO Office by **April 1, 2025.** You may return your information (electronically to Ana Negrete-Garcia at jgerhardt@mseanea.org or by fax to 410-337-7081 or by mail.)

- Applications will be screened by the TABCO Scholarship Committee and recommendations made to the TABCO Board of Directors for final approval.
- High school recipients will be notified at their high school awards program or by June 18th. College recipients will be notified by mail by June 18th.
- Letters will be sent to applicants who do not receive a scholarship, and those individuals may re-apply the following year.
