TABCO Recognition Awards

TABCO Recognition Awards are presented annually in acknowledgment of outstanding persons in the field of education, or from the community, who consistently display dedication to education in Baltimore County, and whose contributions go above and beyond in advocating, promoting and demonstrating such practices as the following: a quality education for students; an awareness of the varied needs of students and educators; sound educational programs and policies; professional and emotional support for educators; a mutual understanding between the educational community and the general public; or, a positive image of education and educators. Recipients must be members of the UEP if they are members of the bargaining unit, or may receive the award as a "friend of education," if not a member of the bargaining unit. However, the primary purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding educators.

Rookie Recognition Awards

This annual award is designed to recognize those individuals who have worked in Baltimore County Public Schools for five or fewer years as of the date the award is given. This award will highlight educators who are successfully developing as professional educators and who are going the extra mile in providing quality education for students and a positive image of education and educators. A person who has demonstrated creativity, implemented a successful project, or done admirable work may be nominated. Care should be taken to select individuals who show great promise to be exemplary educators for years to come. Recipients must be members of the UEP.

1. Both the nominee and the nominator, if eligible, must be TABCO members.
2. Submit the nomination form to TABCO by **Friday, JANUARY 23, 2026**. These must be received or postmarked by that date.
3. The nominator will receive a more detailed nomination form to provide additional, specific information about the nominee's achievements and contributions. This must be accompanied by ten (10) TABCO member signatures seconding the nomination for Recognition; or five (5) TABCO member signatures for Rookie. Present TABCO Officers and Board of Directors members are ineligible to receive an award except in special circumstances, to nominate, or to second a nomination. A minimum of three (3) additional TABCO members must submit letters of support for the nominee, postmarked on or before **Monday, February 23, 2026**.
